

First of all I would like to apologise for the lateness of this Newsletter, but we have been holding on as we have been waiting for accommodation to be confirmed along with the confirmed dates.

We would like to extend our heartfelt thanks to the Headmaster Mr David Campbell, Governors, and staff of Pentland Primary School, Pentland Avenue, Billingham, for stepping in at the last minute and allowing us to turn their school into a “Hotel” for our international guests.

Due to popular demand we are extremely happy to announce that the Middlesbrough Theatre will be the venue for some of the evening concerts again, due to the excellent feedback and attendance, we have decided to extend the evening concerts to hopefully Three Nights during the course of the Festival, with a night totally dedicated to Latin America, alongside the ever popular Carousel and Gala performances.

On-line Booking will be hopefully available from Mid April with the official Box Office Opening Saturday 1st May 2010.

2nd CIOFF INTERNATIONAL PHOTO COMPETITION

The organisers of 2nd CIOFF International Photo Competition received the total of 468 entries from 93 Photographers from 31 Countries (170 Entries in Action-Performance Category, 120 Entries in Friendships between Nations Category and 178 Entries in Portrait in National Costume Category).

The Judging of the Photo Competition took place at the CIOFF World Congress in Havana on 10th November 2009 and was performed anonymously by the members of Festivals Commission and members of Working Group on Public Relations – an International Jury of 12 people from all over the World. Each Member of the Jury scored each Entry on a scale of 1-10. In each Category the Photographs, which will receive the biggest score from all the Jury Members combined, were pronounced as Winners.

Ten first places in each Category will receive CIOFF Diplomas, which will be handed to their respective CIOFF National Delegates. The announcement of the results and presentation ceremony took place on 14th November 2009 at the Closing Ceremony of the CIOFF World Congress in Havana.
