

CZECH REPUBLIC - Vycpalek's Ensemble, Prague



The Josef Vycpalek's Ensemble of Songs and Dances was founded in Prague in 1947. It is the leading dance group in the contemporary Czech folk movement.

The ensemble was named in the honour of Prof. Josef Vycpálek

(1847 – 1922), the author of a unique collection of Czech folk dances. His love and respect for Czech folk songs and dances, folk costumes and instruments have inspired the ensemble to reach the highest level of stylization and reproduction. The evidence of this success can be seen in the true and enduring reputation of the ensemble known by its friends as “Vycpalkovci”, and in the enthusiastic welcome given by thousands of spectators and audiences in the Czech Republic and in many countries abroad.
